## Love water, don't waste it

As the weather warms up and dry conditions continue, it's more important than ever to be water wise. We all have a part to play, and everyone must follow these simple rules.

- Only water lawns and gardens with a sprinkler, irrigation system or hose fitted with a trigger nozzle any day before 10 am and after 4 pm.
- Only use sprinklers or watering systems to establish new lawn and gardens at any time for the first 14 days.
- Use a broom to clean paths, driveways and other hard surfaces. Only use the hose if there is a safety or health concern.
- Only wash vehicles, trailers, boats or buildings using a bucket, high pressure cleaning equipment or a hose fitted with a trigger nozzle.

You can use bore water, recycled water or rainwater (as long as the tank isn't topped up from the drinking water supply) at any time.

Some more simple tips to reduce your water use inside your home include:

- using a plug instead of running water when you're washing your face or brushing your teeth
- keeping some water in the fridge for hot days, instead of waiting for the water to cool from the tap
- thawing frozen food in the microwave instead of under running water.


